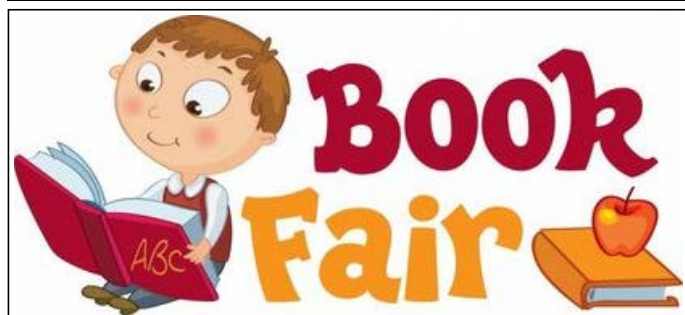

Call to report your child's daily absence by calling the school's attendance line at 662-7990.

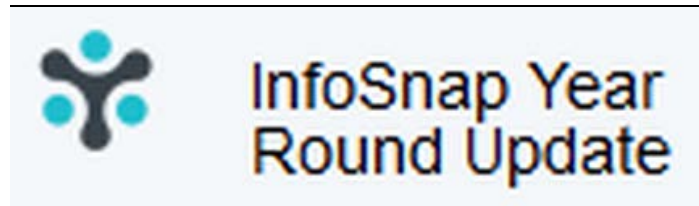
