Soon we will be developing class lists for the 2018-2019 school year. Creating class lists is always a challenge as we try to make sure each student is placed appropriately and each classroom is balanced. We use the following variables to create classrooms that are optimal for learning:

- Balancing the ability levels of students so there is a rich blend of strengths in every classroom
- Placing children who see special teachers in a manner that will facilitate scheduling
- Separating children who have demonstrated conflicts that interfere with their learning and/or the learning of others
- Equalizing class sizes
- Creating a relative balance of boys and girls
- Reflecting on the learning styles of students and teachers

As district elementary schools, we ask that you do not request a specific teacher. If you feel your child has a special need, you can share this information by completing and submitting the [Student Placement Consideration Form](#). If a hard copy is needed please call 662-7958 and we will send one home with your child. Your child will be placed by a committed team of educators who make sure that each classroom is created for ALL of the students. Menu Information Regarding Serving Sizes

Please note that portion sizes posted on NutriSlice may not always accurately reflect our planned portion size for the fruits and vegetables. **The linked production copy shows our planned portion size.** Note that with the strawberries on April 5, NutriSlice shows 1 cup portion, but our planned portion is 1/4 cup. If the student takes 1 scoop of berries, nutritional value would then be based on 1/4 cup, not 1 cup.

Please refer to portion sizes identified on the attached menu when reviewing nutritional value of our menu items until we can correct what's posted to align with our planned serving size. Feel free to contact me with any questions/concerns.

InfoSnap Year Round Update

Have you changed phone numbers, email addresses, work information, etc? If so, the new year-round student information update process for parents is available online!

1. Parent/Guardian will log into the PowerSchool Parent Portal.
2. Once in the portal, choose the appropriate student (changes will need to be done for each child listed in the account).
3. Select InfoSnap Year Round Update on the left side under navigation. (This will take a couple seconds to populate the information that is currently in PowerSchool.)
4. Once the student information is populated, the parent/guardian is free to change the appropriate information such as primary mailing name, contact #, address, mother/father/guardian information, and emergency contact information.
