Student Information Update and School Fees

Have you updated your child's information in InfoSnap through PowerSchool? If not, please do so promptly. Here's a link to get you

If you have not yet remitted payment for your child's annual fees, you may do so online using the Student Quick
Pay feature on the district's website. You may pay fees for all of your children who attend the Howard-Suamico School District. You will need to know your child's Student Id. Student Ids were listed on your child's placement email. If you prefer to pay by cash or check, you can remit payment to school with your child. 2017-2018 school fees are as follows: Grades K-4 - \$20.00 Textbook Rental Fee. An additional \$35.00 Technology Insurance Fee applies only to 3rd and 4th grade.

Importance of School Attendance!

If your child will be absent due to an appointment, it is recommended that you attain an excuse from your provider for the date and time of the visit and return the excuse to the school office. This will ensure that the absence is noted as an excused absence or tardy. Appointment cards will NOT be accepted as an excuse.
